A toddler has a temperature of 40 degrees

Parent takes child to nearest A&E

Child is triaged immediately and seen by a Dr within $\frac{1}{2}$ hour

Medication to lower temperature given; child monitored for 2 hs.

Improvement -sent home with further medication; parent reassured, come back if necessary

Outcome: child home and recovers

Cost Monthly NI/taxation on income.

Parent (with basic private health insurance) takes child to nearest A&E

Hospital won't treat - not affiliated to her Health Ins.

Parent told to take child to correct hospital 70 miles away!

Contacts 2^{nd} hospital-requests fund transfer-Refused. $\frac{1}{2}$ hr

Is told to bring child to 2nd hospital- 70 miles away 2hrs

Ability to pay is investigated! 30mins

Child admitted and triaged. 15mins

Child starts fitting Outcome - death of child

Cost \$200 dollars per month all of working life; \$2000 excess to be paid as child admitted to hospital- despite no treatment

These scenarios are based on real cases.
